Ukrainian director and screenwriter. He wrote and directed "When the Trees Fall" and published "The Abyss", a collection of short stories that won the "Oles Ulianenko" International Literary Award. During the residency she focused his work on the theme of war and the pain and traumas that war causes.

Matteo Oleotto

Italian director and actor, graduated from the "Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia" in Rome. He wrote and directed "Zoran, il mio nipote scemo" (Zoran, my stupid nephew), that won awards at several festivals and it was nominated for the "David di Donatello" and "Nastro d'Argento" for best storyline.




FUTURE

BANDO DI CONCORSO BORDERLESS SCRIPTWRITING RESIDENCY



Transmedia s.r.l.



The Transmedia Srl Company, in collaboration with the Palazzo del Cinema - Hiša Filma Association and with the "Sergio Amidei" Cultural Association, opens an international competition for two artistic residencies dedicated to writing for the audiovisual sector.

The residency includes accreditation for the 42nd "Sergio Amidei" International Award for Best Screenplay, where the participants will present the outcome of their work as a public pitch to a group of producers.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Authors, at least 18 years old, can apply for the Screenwriters Residence with a project in Italian, Slovenian or English, suitable for the creation of a screenplay for an audiovisual product.

The projects must be focused on the identity of the crossborder territory that features the area of Gorizia and Nova Gorica. This environment should inspire the two winners in the creation of the plot to submit to the commission in order to take part in the contest, as well as in the development of the finished screenplay.

As final result of the residency for screenwriters, the authors will create two screenplays for feature films, short films or medium-length films, both fiction and documentary. Transmedia s.r.l. undertakes to promote them with the aim of reaching potentially interested producers.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application must contain the following documentation:

- motivation letter
- the residency project (max 3 pages)
- curriculum vitae
- copy of the ID card

Each candidate can apply with only one project. All material must be sent in PDF format to the email info@transmedia.it no later than April 30th 2023.

The Commission will evaluate the individual projects and communicate the winners of the competition by 1 June 2023.

The winners will be contacted at the stated addresses in the sent documentation.

The winners of the contest will be hosted in the city of Gorizia for a few weeks between June and July 2023. Food and accommodation is included, as well as a contribution for ancillary expenses.
